Mrs. Lilia Harding's Home-going Service

On Monday, March 13, 2017, the family and friends of Mrs. Lilia Harding along members of her church, Bible Baptist Church, celebrated her heavenly home-going. The 10 AM funeral service was held at Central Baptist Church in Southington, CT, with burial at Oak Hill Cemetery. The family gave testimony, the congregation sang songs, and her pastor, Dr. Thomas M. Strouse gave the eulogy and salvation message. Afterward the attendees were invited to her son-in-law's Lola's Bistro for the reception. Dr. Strouse's eulogy of this repentant sinner's saved life included the following:

- *She was a good wife and mother and loved her family, raising three wonderful children.
- *She was unselfish in her dedicated service to others.

*As her Pastor, I appreciated her Christian commitment, spiritual gift of service, interest in hearing the Bible, doing God's will, and the fact that she was a great prayer warrior always wanting to pray for others.

*We met her in 2000 when we first came to CT. We struck an initial and lasting bond with her because of physical age and spiritual perspective.

*We realized she loved the Lord, loved His word, and loved serving Him.

*She told me she always prayed for her children and grandchildren as well as her pastor and his family.

*She worked with my wife Jan on many projects with a creative eye, including seminary banquets

and church decorations.

*On several occasions she opened her home and swimming pool for our baptismal services.

*She enrolled in several seminary Bible courses including first year Greek and first year Hebrew. She was a diligent student of Scripture.

*In the end she proofread the first three chapters of my commentary on Hebrews, always giving insight into the text and corrections of references. Now she knows the reality of the figures and shadows of the OT and is probably thinking that her pastor needs to dig deeper into the book because she now has absolute knowledge. I have dedicated my commentary to her.

*When she discovered that she had a few months to live she hoped that her funeral would not be in the cold snowy month of January. The Lord answered that prayer.

Included in the funeral service is her salvation testimony:

Mrs. Lilia Harding's Testimony (July 22, 1947-March 8, 2017)

I grew up in a Christian home in Poland. My family attended a Bible believing church. Sunday school was my favorite time on Sunday. I was always brought to tears hearing the stories of Jesus. I thought that was my salvation because I believed.

As a teenager I moved to America with my family. Christians always find other Christians since the Lord leads us this way. During my first year of marriage I realized that I had no peace in my heart about salvation and how a person can be sure they are going to heaven when they die. An older Christian lady told of her assurance of salvation upon her repentance of her sin and trusting by faith in the Lord Jesus. She stressed to me to search the Scriptures. That is when my understanding began. The Lord showed me through the Scriptures and through sitting under teaching and preaching of godly men at the local church we attended that I needed a complete turnaround.

I repented of my sins against the Lord. I trusted Him as my personal Saviour putting my faith in His blood paid on the cross for me. I read the Bible and studied to know who my Redeemer is. All this that I have written is for no glory to me, but all honor and glory goes to the merciful, loving Lord Jesus, my God and my Saviour. He it is who loved me (the unlovable wicked sinner) and gave Himself on the cross that I may have eternal life through His precious blood spilled on the cross for me. He gave His life willingly and no one could take it away from Him. He is God, and when God the Father looks at me, the miserable sinner, the Lord Jesus will stand before me and proclaim me His own, washed clean by His blood.

This is the absolute wonder of it all. All praise and glory be to God for the greatest sacrifice of "His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him

should not perish but have everlasting life" (Jn. 3:16). And now I know for sure through the truth of God's Holy Word that I am saved and have eternal life. As I write this I am praying that you also will seek the Lord and surrender to Him that I shall see you in heaven.

My favorite verses are "The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower" (Ps. 18:2) and "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name" (Jn. 1:12).


BBTS MODULES IN ENDICOTT, NY





Naomi

Ruth 1:1 Now it came to pass in the days when the judges ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehemjudah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons.

Ruth 1:2 And the name of the man was Elimelech, and the name of his wife Naomi, and the name of his two sons Mahlon and Chilion, Ephrathites of Bethlehemjudah. And they came into the country of Moab, and continued there.

Reflection: Sometimes a husband will lead wrongly. What is a woman to do? Will the Lord make a way? I wonder what kind of faith Elimelech had. Did he trust the Lord to provide or was he going to make his own way? He led his family to Moab which was a pagan land.

1 Kings 11:33 Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do that which is right in mine eyes, and to keep my statutes and my judgments, as did David his father.

The two sons now married women from Moab which worshiped other gods. The Lord takes the lives of all three men in this family. After Elimelech died the two sons had the choice to lead their families back to the land of Judah from where they came and did not. Now Naomi is left

to make these decisions and she goes back to Bethlehem.

GROW IN GRACE

Ruth 1:19 So they two went until they came to Bethlehem. And it came to pass, when they were come to Bethlehem, that all the city was moved about them, and they said, Is this Naomi?

In Verse 19, one can surmise that those in the city survived this famine. Had Elimelech stayed and trusted, the Lord would have provided.

Challenge: It is vital in decision making you are certain you are in the will of the Lord and not compromising Truth for error. How often are we tempted to take matters into our own hands? Are there decisions that you are making today that are based on circumstances rather then the will of God? Decisions based on escaping a situation? The Lord will reward faithfulness and obedience to Him, be sure you are in His will.

As you submit to your husband's leadership, even when not in agreement, trust the Lord with the outcome and pray.
