## **IRELAND MODULE**

uring the week of January 6-10, 2025, Dr. Thomas M. Strouse taught the module on Greek Exegesis II and the first book of Psalms 1-41. The former class (8 AM-1 PM had nine students including pastors and church members. The latter class with some of the same seminarians was in the evening (5-10 PM) with twenty in-person seminarians and five on live stream. The first book of Psalms 1-41 is replete with the psalms of David, 23 out of 41 alluding to the ouster by Absalom and Ahithophel. Since David was the sweet psalmist of Israel, the assumption is that he

wrote all psalms that did not have another's name attached or that the content was contrary to davidic authorship.

Along with the first book of Psalms is the second book, Psalms 42-72, which continues with 19 out of 31 Psalms referring to the ouster of King David. The significance of this emphasis is that Jehovah promised an everlasting dynasty to David (II Sam. 7:12-16), which promise seemed in great jeopardy from the human perspective. If Absalom and Ahithophel would have been victorious in the attempted coup, the consequences would have potentially damaged the eschatology of the divine plan of the Cross and the Millennium. Hence, King David knew he was the rightful king and continued to petition the LORD for personal grace and perpetual fulfillment of the plan of God. The Lord gave promises to three institutions for the saints of God which institutions Satan and his cohorts attempted to thwart. He promised Abraham the Land of Canaan (Gen. 12:1-3), David the everlasting davidic dynasty (II Sam. 7:12-16), and Peter the perpetuity of the Baptist assembly (Mt. 16:18). Imprecatory prayers were leveled at those attempting to thwart the divine promises. For instance, David imprecated Absalom and Ahithophel (Pss. 69:28; 55:13-15, respectively), Peter imprecated Ananias and Priscella (Acts 5:1-10) and Simon Magus (Acts 8:20-24), and Paul imprecated Hymenaeus and Alexander (I Tim. 1:20). The context of Psalms helps believers to see the magnitude of what was at stake and the extreme prayers of imprecations toward the enemies of God's institutions!

On Sunday January 5, Dr. Strouse preached at the church of Pastor Gene McKinley over Good News Baptist Church and at River Valley Baptist Church with Pastor Aleksei Jusev. Both men are graduates of BBTS as well as several others in attendance, namely Pastor Derry O'Sullivan, Pastor Stephen Finley, and Pastor David Ellsmore, and Mr. Tom Baker.

Dr. Strouse stayed with Mrs. Kathi Zemeski along with several other women chaperones during the week. Dr. Bob Zemeski was the founder of River Valley Baptist Church and pastored until his recent death. Although the weather was cold, snowy, and damp, the fellowship was warm and enjoyable.

# FAIRHAVEN BAPTIST COLLEGE MODULE

The following week, Dr. Strouse taught the module at Fairhaven Baptist College in Chesterton, IN on Psalms 42-72 to nine seminarians. It was good to see some of seminary graduates of BBTS, such as Pastor Dr. Jeremy Mitchell, former dean Pastor Dan Armacost and current missionary to Myanmar, and Dr. Clint Schreiber. Dr. Mitchell pastors Fairhaven Baptist Church and oversees Fairhaven Baptist College which is under the *aegis* of the church.

Pray for Kirsten as continues with her cancer treatment. Her new treatment since it was revealed that the cancer had metastasized began on November 4th and is one day a week, lasting about 3 hours, every other week. In addition, every two months she will have a CT Scan to monitor the progress of the tumor. Her first scan was on December 30, which showed little change from the previous scan in October. because that is exactly what the treatment is designed to do—keep the cancer from spreading. The doctor was pleased with the results and we will continue this current treatment until the next scan at the end of February, at which time we will reassess.
