THE REDIVIVUS OF EVE IN AMERICAN MARRIAGES

Introduction

Disclaimer: Adam and his fellow men are the problem for the revival of Eve in American marriages as this essay addresses the acknowledgement and avoidance of “Feminism” for both Christian men and women.

Scripture

“Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? The “Eve” movement has reversed the God-given roles of man over women and produced matriarchy throughout America if not the whole world. For Adam was first formed, then Eve. And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.”* (I Tim. 2:12-14). Unless a Christian woman recognizes that she has been conditioned by society, government, and weak biblical teaching, she will allow “Eve” to arise in her heart and continue the cycle of the “redivivus of Eve.” Furthermore, men need to take over their patriarchal role of

headship in the family, church, and society, and honor their Head, the Lord Jesus Christ, as the Apostle Paul asserted, saying, *“But I would have you know, that the head of every man is Christ; and the head of the woman is the man; and the head of Christ is God”* (I Cor. 11:3). Upon whom does the blame fall? Adam was all too willing to surrender his headship over his wife and the animal realm, and Eve was all too willing to take control, submitting to an inferior creature, and chaos and damnation fell upon Jehovah’s perfect creation! The following chart uses the rubrics of Economy, Religion, Society, World, Technology, Culture, Education, Family to show influences producing the downward drift of the Christian family unit and the ascendancy of a “feminist” America. The generalizations are subjective and mine, having lived in or through all six generations.

1928-1945 > The Silent Generation:

Economy > Post depression, frugality, menial employment for men.

Religion > Basically, a “Judaeo-Christian” society, fundamentalism ascends, public morality and ethics expected.

Society > Traditional conservative values, very patriotic, patriarchy prominent.

World > The spectre of WW II prominent.

Technology > The advancement of the radio and telephone

Culture > Humbled society by wartime

Education > Public education conservative (teaches the 3 “R”s), Ten Commandments taught, prayer in schools.

Family > Biblical roles of father who works, mother stays home, and children expected to be obedient. Divorce forbidden by church and society.

1946-1964 > The Baby Boomers:

Economy > Post-war prosperity, frugality, increase in consumerism, employment for men and women.

Religion > Basically a weaker “Christian” society, fundamentalism and mega-church movements, morality and ethics are challenged.

Society > Traditional conservative values, very patriotic, matriarchy ascends.

World > Post WWII perspective.

Technology > Television replaces radios. Technology advances.

Culture > Rock & Roll assaults parents and excites teenagers; fornication ascends.

Education > Main role of public education begins to weaken because of freedoms in society

Family > Biblical roles of father and mother weaken with mother working to help support the American Dream of beautiful homes and multiple vehicles. Children become independent. Divorces increase and accepted by society and church. Birth rate begins to decline.

1965-1980 > The Generation X:

Economy > Prosperity continues with dual incomes and women advancing careers

Religion > Advancement of women within ministry and true biblical spirituality declines.

Society > Anti-authority perspective on all institutions. Women are equal to men in society and family. Men are diminished in roles. Abortion becomes form of birth-control.

World > Vietnam war and other worldwide skirmishes.

Culture > Radicalization of youth with degenerative forms of music.

Education > Public education becomes more politicized with socialism.

Family > Matriarchy becomes queen, men/fathers absent physically and emotionally, family structure eliminated. Divorce accepted and expected and birth rate plunges.

1997-2012 > Generation Z:

Economy > Extreme materialism and consumerism

Religion > Little influence with biblical Christianity, Bible translations flourish, Catholicism abounds.

Society > Extreme carnality, socialism on the rise.

World > Globalism on the rise.

Technology > Cell phones ascend throughout the world with youth benumbed by the heroine Eve!

Culture > Secularism triumphs over Christianity.

Education > Socialism/Communism peak in public schools.

Family > Family unit is chaotic with no structure or father influence. Why marry? Birth rate nil!
