#### TIMELESS TRUTHS BIBLE CONFERENCE

#### NATIONAL REFORM

The LORD raised up young Josiah as the final godly king for the Southern Kingdom to bring national reform to Judah. The Chronicler revealed the spiritual stages of the great grandson of Hezekiah, enumerating decisive times in his life. For instance, Josiah became King of Judah when he was eight years old (640 BC) and reigned for thirty-one years, dying by the hand of Pharaoh (609 BC), according to II Chr. 34:1 and II Chr. 35:20 ff. At sixteen, he sought the LORD and at twenty began his national reformation (II Chr. 34:3). He attempted to reform the nation religiously to bring Judah back to the national worship of Jehovah as prescribed in the Tanak. He destroyed the pagan images and restored the Temple (II Chr. 34:3-8). When he was twenty-six the "book of the law of the LORD given by Moses" was discovered (II Chr. 34:14).

National reformation, however, always needs spiritual revival to maintain the movement (c. 622 BC). The LORD raised up a group of prophets to help sustain the national effort by King Josiah. Jeremiah submitted to the will of Jehovah and began preaching His message, saying, "Amend your ways and your doings, and I will cause you to dwell in this place" (Jer. 7:3, 5; cf. also 26:13; 35:15). Nahum had a message meant to encourage the Southern Kingdom that her arch enemy, Nineveh of Assyria (Nah. 1:1; 3:7), would soon be destroyed by another nation (612 BC). Zephaniah arose to the reformation effort of King Josiah (620 BC) and warned that the Day of the LORD was imminent (Zeph. 1:7, 14-16). He prophesied about the coming terrible judgment and encouraged the Jews to "Seek ve the LORD" (Zeph. 2:3) before it was too late! About 606 BC, the Prophet Habakkuk recognized that Judah needed divine visitation but questioned Jehovah's use of the Chaldeans (Hab. 1:2-6). The LORD answered the query of the prophet with the requirement of trust, saying, "the just shall live by his faith" (Hab. 2:4). In the end, Habakkuk was left with trusting in the wisdom and ways of God, saying, "Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation" (Hab. 3:18). Two other spiritual giants of the LORD, coeval with King Josiah, were Daniel and Ezekiel, both deported to Babylon in 605 BC and 597 BC, respectively.

#### ARTICLE CONCLUSION

Obviously, National Reform is beneficial only if it is based on biblical precepts and practices, and supported by the LORD's scriptural institution. For Judah, the *Tanak* was the guide book for biblical worship, beginning in the heart of the devotees. Hosea wrote about the LORD's desire for Israel, saying, "For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings" (Hos. 6:4). The chosen people in the Promised Land were to worship Jehovah from their respective hearts under the guidance of the teaching of the priests and the challenge of His prophets. The Northern Kingdom failed and received decimation in 722 BC by the Assyrians. The Southern Kingdom was on the verge of failure in this last surge of reform by King Josiah, and eventually fell in 586 BC to the Babylonians. Jeremiah declared that the original plan of the LORD to turn His original creation from "without form and void" (Gen. 1:2) to a place on the created land (Gen. 1:10) to put the Garden of Eden and eventually the "city of peace" (Jerusalem) for Adam and Eve and their "godly seed" (Mal. 2:15) to raise the "family of man," was now destroyed and everything went back to "without form and void" (Jer. 4:23)! Following destruction came restoration. The merciful and gracious Jehovah will have a believing remnant of the Family of Man, via the death, burial, and resurrection of the precious Jesus Christ, adopted into the Family of God, and living with Him throughout eternity in New Jerusalem (Rev. 21:2; 22:17)!

In this Baptist Dispensation (cf. Mk. 1:1-4; Mt. 3:16; Acts 2:38-41), the LORD's spiritual movement is the biblical Baptist assembly, albeit relatively small, as the divinely designated entity for individual regeneration behind any national reform, and not some national coalition of ecumenical religionists comprised of Charismatics, Catholics, Protestants, Hindus, and Jews, bringing about national prosperity and even world peace (shades of Rev. 6:1-2)!

Baptist pastors, stay true to your biblical calling of propagating the Great Commission by evangelizing, baptizing, and catechizing your Jerusalem!
